"SUMMARY: To authorize imposition of a LOCAL SALES AND SERVICES TAX in the City of Laurel, County of Marshall at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2015 until June 30, 2025.

PUBLIC MEASURE C

A LOCAL SALES AND SERVICES TAX shall be imposed in the City of Laurel, County of Marshall, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2025.

Revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated in the City of Laurel, County of Marshall, as follows:

1. Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.
2. Fifty percent (50%) for the continuation of the resurfacing of the streets and alleys and the continuation of maintenance of the streets and alleys within the City of Laurel, Iowa.
3. Fifty percent (50%) for use in the General Fund for any lawful purpose of the City of Laurel, Iowa."
