
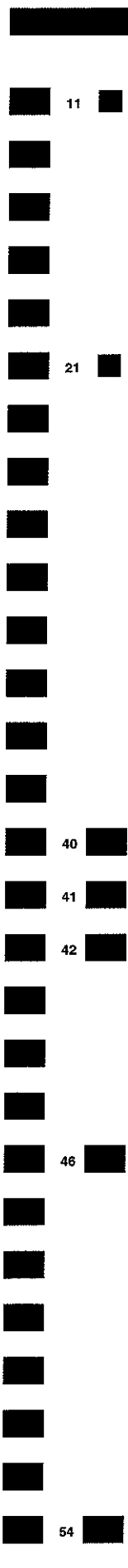

PUBLIC MEASURE A A LOCAL SALES AND SERVICES TAX shall be imposed in the City of Marshalltown, County of Marshall, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2025. Revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated in the City of Marshalltown, County of Marshall, as follows: 1. Seventy-five percent (75%) for general property tax relief. 2. Five percent (5%) for any lawful purpose of the City of Marshalltown. 3. Twenty percent (20%) for capital improvements, including storm sewer improvements and related street repairs."
