"Shall the City of State Center, Iowa, ("City") renew its franchise with Alliant Energy Company ("Company"), its successors and assigns, for a natural gas distribution system in the City for a period of twenty-five (25) years subject to a limited right of cancellation at the end of the fifteenth (15) year, imposing a franchise fee of five percent (5 %) on the gross receipts from the distribution, supply or sale of natural gas for customers within the limits of the City, except for distribution, supply or sale directly to the City, beginning in January or July following approval by the Company, said funds to be devoted entirely to general property tax relief by payment into the City's general fund?"
