








Bird Watching Guide

Visitors from the North. Years in which the cone crop in boreal regions is low, cone seed eating birds come south in search of food. This appears to be one of those years!

- Watch for these visitors at your bird feeders and keep them full of sunflower seed, suet, peanuts, and nyger.
- Watch for Snowy Owls atop utility poles, hay bales, fence posts, and sitting on the ground.
